

SCHOOL COMMITTEE OPERATIONAL GOALS

The School Committee is committed to providing all students equal but not necessarily identical opportunities to achieve commensurate with their abilities. The School Committee will maintain an awareness of the concerns and desires of the community regarding the quality and performance of the school system. The School Committee will employ a Superintendent who will ensure that Biddeford maintains its position as an outstanding school system and under whose leadership school administration and staff will carry out the policies of the School Committee with imagination and dedication.

The School Committee commits itself to the following operational objectives:

- A. Provide strategic leadership for the school unit;
- B. Interpret the educational needs and aspirations of the community, and meet them through the formulation of policies which serve the best interests of the students;
- C. Provide sufficient guidance to the Superintendent to implement the goals and objectives of the school system as set forth in the School Committee policy manual;
- D. Maintain effective communication with the constituencies served by the schools;
and
- E. Evaluate School Committee policies and the educational program to ensure that goals and objectives are met.
