The most notable changes are the new staff and student parking lot on Maplewood Avenue, nearly complete foundations for the three additions, and structural steel for the music wing, as seen in the photos below. Extensive renovation has begun in the first of four classroom blocks, and will continue until Spring 2011, when renovation will begin on the second block.

Construction activities will be ongoing throughout the entirety of the school year. Upcoming Activities September 2010

The month of September brings continued work on both foundations and structural steel for the three additions, and neighbors, staff, and students alike will begin to see these spaces take shape over the next several weeks. Demolition of the existing Guidance Wing and stair tower near White Gym, as well as selective demolition in the West Wing, is scheduled for the beginning of the month to accommodate the new library and administration wing addition. As mentioned in last month's newsletter, Guidance offices have been relocated next to the cafeteria. Also this month, masonry framing begins on the new elevator and stair tower next to Tiger Gym.
