

ADMINISTRATIVE GOALS

School administrators are responsible, within the guidelines established by School Committee policy, for the direction of students and staff in their efforts to reach educational goals adopted by the School Committee. The Superintendent is expected to provide overall leadership for the administrative team in meeting these goals. The administration shall have latitude to develop and implement the best possible educational program within the parameters of School Committee policy and will be held accountable for the effectiveness of the program.

However, the mere execution of directives does not, by itself, constitute effective administration of the schools. The School Committee expects the administration to exhibit vision, initiative, resourcefulness and concern for students, staff and parents in performing its duties and responsibilities.
