

EDUCATIONAL TECHNICIAN SUBSTITUTES

The School Committee authorizes the employment of educational technical substitutes to serve on a day-to-day basis in the following circumstances:

A. Special Education

1. When an educational technician whose primary responsibility is to provide one-on-one services to student(s) as recommended by a PET is absent; or
2. Under other circumstances as deemed appropriate by the building administrator in consultation with the Special Education Director.

B. Regular Education

1. When an Ed. Tech III who teaches a particular curriculum area is absent from school, a substitute may be employed to avoid disruption of the instructional program.
