

**ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS
ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION**

Residency Requirement for Enrollment In Biddeford Schools

The Biddeford School District is funded by the City of Biddeford. Therefore, the following conditions apply to enrollment:

- All children who are residents of Biddeford and who meet legislated age requirements may attend the Biddeford Public Schools.
- Proof of residence is required for all registered students. Such proof consists of a tax bill, a valid lease, or a notarized statement by the residence owner acknowledging current tenancy.
- School Committee policy states that when doubt arises as to whether or not a child is residing in the Biddeford School District, the burden of proof shall rest with the family/guardian.
- A child to be enrolled in the Biddeford Public Schools must actually live in Biddeford.
- Registration of a student who doesn't actually reside in Biddeford may result in liability of the registering parent or guardian for tuition charges.
