

STUDENT CONDUCT

Citizenship in a democracy requires respect for the rights of others. Students in the Biddeford school system shall be expected to conduct themselves in such a way that the rights and privileges of others are not violated. Students shall respect constituted authority, conform to school rules and regulations, and to those provisions of law which apply to the conduct of juveniles or minors.

Teachers and other members of the school staff shall emphasize and model for students high standards of courtesy, morality, honesty, constructive relationships with others, and pride in one's work and achievements.
